The beautifully designed gates of the Kaddish Prayer that once graced the Holocaust Room, will now welcome you at the entrance of the new Memorial/Holocaust Room.

Along with additional room for memorial plaques as our congregation continues to grow, our beautiful Memorial/Holocaust Room is now a combined space where we can mourn everyone we hold dear.

Judaism teaches us that names are sacred and should be remembered. Purchasing a memorial plaque for \$360 is a meaningful way to be a permanent part of Kol Ami. You may purchase a plaque to permanently memorialize a loved one, or you may prepay to reserve a plaque for yourself.
